Jeanne A. Meleo 69, of Bonita Springs died Saturday, February 4, 2017 at Jackson Memorial Hospital, Miami, FL due to medical complications. She had been a resident of Bonita Springs for the past 10 years coming from Tyngsboro, MA.
