Jeffrey P. Marsh, aka "Batman" 46, of Bonita Springs, died December 29, 2021, at NCH-Baker. He was born on April 28, 1975, in Niagara Falls, NY a son of John C. and Patricia (White) Marsh, Sr. He had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 1995 coming from Niagara Falls, NY.

He attended St. John De La Salle School, La Salle Jr. High School, and graduated from La Salle Sr. High School in Niagara Falls.

Jeff was the modern-day MacGyver; he had the ability to fix or make anything. This ability led him to his career. He was the owner of A-2nd Look Home Services. He was also the former Chief Engineer at the Hilton Garden Inn, Ft Myers, the Director of Engineering at both the Sanibel Harbour Marriot Resort and the Hilton Naples.

He was the recipient of the E-Awards 2016, the Elaine McLaughlin Outstanding Hospitality Service Award-Good Samaritan, the 2011 Manager of the Year – Hilton Naples, and nominated for the Hilton Worldwide Spirit Award.

He loved his daughter with his whole heart and loved EVERYTHING Batman.

He enjoyed riding his motorcycle, playing pool, and singing Karaoke. He always loved spending time with his friends and volunteering at various Service Organization events. One of his favorite recent pastimes was painting miscellaneous figurines and plaques.
