Jerry L. Plummer, 79 of Estero, FL and Carmel, IN passed away Saturday, June 5, 2021, after a long illness. He had been a winter resident of Pelican Sound in Estero for over 20 years. Jerry was born December 31, 1941 in Odon, IN a son of the late Charles D. and Edna Maxine (Gibson) Plummer.

Jerry served his country in the United States National Guard.

He was a graduate of Indiana State University where he earned his bachelor's degree in business administration.
