In 1984 John started a company called Digital Processing Systems. It grew exponentially, going worldwide. In 2000 the company received an Emmy for outstanding achievement in engineering development in the television industry. Later the company was sold and John retired to Florida in 2002.

John was a member of the Knights of Columbus and was involved in all aspects of the organization. He loved to travel and obtained his pilot's license in his younger years. He enjoyed golfing, fishing and cruising. John will be sadly missed and lovingly remembered by all his family and dear friends.

John was the beloved husband of Josephine "Josie" (nee Howman), for 32 years. Proud father of his children, Jane (Mike) Radford and Robert (Agnes) Fazackerley.
