John Hastings of Bonita Springs, FL passed away suddenly Tuesday, June 07, 2022. He will be deeply missed by his wife Sharon, family and friends after recently celebrating 60 years of marriage this past May. He was due to celebrate his 85th birthday this coming July 03.

John was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario in 1937. After graduating from Pitt St. Collegiate High School in Sault Ste. Marie, John continued, through study and apprenticeship, to become a Chartered Accountant in September 1963. He soon embarked on a promising career in Hospital Administration working at Plummer Hospital, Sault Ste. Marie, as President of The Civic Hospital, North Bay and eventually as President of the Metropolitan General Hospital of Windsor, Ontario.

John was a hard-working and caring leader, cultivating numerous life-long friendships and inspiring those he worked with. John was a Life Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives and a Life Member of The Chartered Professional Accounts of Ontario.

He was thrilled to sing for a number of years with the Symphonic Chorale of Southwest Florida. John was immensely proud of his son Joel's musical career, was his premier fan and happily encouraged any and all to listen to his recordings and performances.

John and Sharon enjoyed countless travels around the world and loved traveling far and wide with family and friends.

After residing in Sault Ste. Marie, North Bay, and Windsor Ontario, John eventually retired to SW Florida in 1998 with Sharon. In retirement, he also enjoyed working as a concierge for a number of years at the Inn at Pelican Bay, Naples FL and The Inn on Fifth, Naples FL.

John also had a life-long passion as a steadfast believer of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. John attended the Gospel Hall in Sault Ste. Marie, Bethel Gospel Chapel North Bay, Oakwood Bible Chapel, Windsor, First Baptist Church, Naples and the First Presbyterian Church of Bonita Springs. His faith guided his life and was evident daily in the love, care and honesty he showed to everyone around him.
