John Pandolfo 82, of Bonita Springs died Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at Naples Community Hospital after a brief illness. He was born on June 22, 1935 in Far Rockaway, NY s son of the late Mathew and Florence (LaBerge) Pandolfo. John had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 1988 coming from Massapequa Park, NY.

He began his career in law enforcement in 1961 with the Nassau County Police Department and retired at the rank of Detective in 1988.
