



## Joseph Peter Moran

June 11, 1960 - April 16, 2021

On Friday, April 16, 2021 Joseph Peter Moran, 60, of Bonita Springs, Florida died in Joanne's House at Hope Hospice. He was born in Fort Worth, Texas, a son of Mary Ann Kaul Robinson and the late Joseph Curtis Moran.

Joe grew up in Wisconsin and made history by becoming the youngest certified air conditioning technician in the state of Wisconsin in 1979. In 1987 Joe moved south to Bonita Springs.
