Joseph Kenneth Dakota Pronovost, 25 of Naples, Florida died Monday, October 31, 2022. Formerly of Jacksonville, FL he had been a resident of Naples since 2008. Joe was born October 14, 1997 in Jacksonville, the son of Larry and Sharon (Johnson) Pronovost.
