Judy M. Meyers, 77, passed away peacefully on Jan. 19, 2021, at her home in Bonita Springs, FL, after a long struggle with COPD. Judy was active in their data services business for 25 years, and later she and Les lived on Lake Koshkonong and became snowbirds in FL and then permanent residents after retirement. An excellent cook, Judy loved to host dinners and travel with her family and close friends. A highlight was spending time with her four grandchildren at the beach and on their boat.
