Karen J. Rohovsky 75, of Bonita Springs, FL died Sunday, December 31, 2017. She was born February 2, 1942 in Sugarcreek, OH the daughter of the late Paul M. and Mary E. (Funk) Andreas. A former resident of New Hope, PA, she had resided in Bonita Springs since 2006.

After graduating high school, she attended the Ohio State University where she received her Bachelor's degree in 1964 and her Master's degree in Speech Pathology in 1965. She worked in various schools in Massachusetts before moving to Pennsylvania. She opened her private practice in Doylestown, PA in 1977 and operated the practice until 1991 when she moved back to Massachusetts.

Since 2004, she has made individual comfort pillows for breast cancer patients in Northern Virginia.
