Katherine Jane Guglielmi Wolf, 97, of Naples, Florida passed away peacefully, March 27, 2025, at AVOW Hospice in Naples, Florida,

Katherine was born in Curwensville, PA on June 24, 1927, the first daughter of Edward and Theresa (Feola) Guglielmi. She was a graduate of Curwensville High School in 1945. She worked at Kantar's Store in Curwensville, during and after high school and later as a telephone operator for the Pennsylvania Bell Telephone Company.

She married Robert Patton Wolf, Jr., also of Curwensville, in 1950. They subsequently moved to Akron, OH for Robert's work at B. F. Goodrich Tire Company. Here, she worked as a telephone operator for B. F. Goodrich, rising to assistant manager of phone operations there until the birth of her eldest daughter.

She also lived in Cinnaminson, NJ for six years when Robert's work at B. F. Goodrich took them there. Besides raising her daughters, Suzannah and Rebecca, she worked as a receptionist for one year at Wood Conversion Company, nearby.

When they returned to Ohio to live in Cuyahoga Falls, Katherine was a member in the neighborhood bridge club, and a Mission Club member for

Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, in Cuyahoga Falls, of which she was a parishioner. She also volunteered as a monitor for lunch duty at IHM several days a week. She then worked 25 years for the Cuyahoga Falls City Schools as a study hall monitor and educational aid. She and Robert retired in Naples, FL.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Robert P. Wolf, Jr., her parents, and three siblings, Cosmo R. Guglielmi, Alliene A. (Guglielmi) Johnstone, and Norma J. (Guglielmi) Barnoff and their respective wife and husbands.

Katherine is survived by her daughters, Suzannah Wolf Walker, of Taos, NM and Rebecca Ann Gannon and son-in-law, John P. Gannon of Dublin, OH. She is also survived by her grandchildren, Megan E.
