Kenneth M. Huth, 88, of Bonita Springs, Florida formerly of Sarver PA, passed away peacefully with his loving family by his side on September 1, 2020. Ken was born July 5, 1932 in Freeport, son of Charles J. Huth and Agnes (Hause) Huth. He was a 1950 graduate of Freeport High School where he enjoyed playing football and basketball. 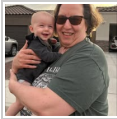
