Kenneth Craig Lougheed, 76, passed away peacefully on December 2, 2020. He was preceded in death by his parents Robert and Marie Lougheed, brother Robert Lougheed, and sister Dorothy Cooper.

Upon return, he began a career as operation manager with Allstate Insurance Company, Kemper, and Crum & Foster. Transferred to the Chicago area, he raised his children in Hoffman Estates, Illinois. Craig was a wonderful husband

and father. He was an active member of Holy Family Catholic Church. Craig spent many winters skiing with family, summer vacations at the Jersey Shore, country dancing, and enjoying time with life-long friends.

Craig retired to Hilton Head Island and, in 2011, moved to Bonita Springs where he basked in the sun and did all things Florida.
