Kenneth Marvill, 85, of Bonita Springs, FL passed away Thursday, October 6, 2016 at his residence. Formerly of Pennsylvania, he had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 1993. Ken was born April 27, 1931 in Philadelphia, PA a son of the late Henry and Dorothy (Wisler) Marvill Sr.
