Kenneth Ronald "Kenny" Simon, 77, of Indianapolis, IN, passed away on Wednesday, March 29, 2017 in Ft. Myers, FL. He had been a seasonal Florida resident for the last 17 years. He was born September 30, 1939 in Indianapolis, the son of Robert and June Simon.
