He instilled in his daughters the belief that they could achieve anything, encouraging them to pursue careers not typical for women of their time. He took great pride in his grandchildren, celebrating their successes and supporting them wholeheartedly.

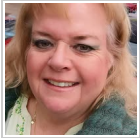

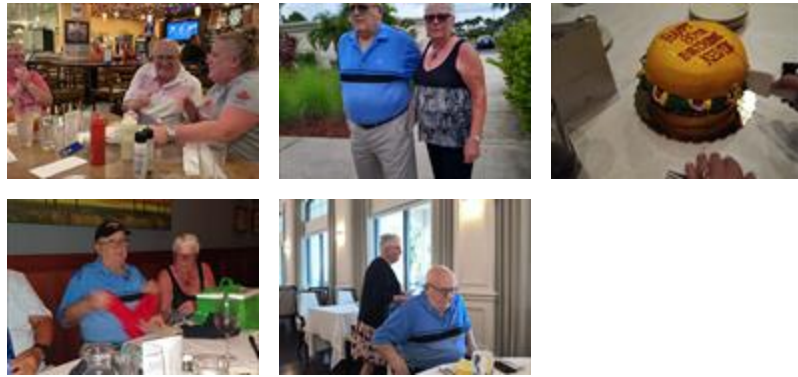
