Lilian Hall Fisher died peacefully at home in Naples, Florida on September 21, 2016.

She was born on June 5, 1918, in Grand Rapids, Michigan, daughter of Edith Chase Hall Harmon and Marcus B. Hall.

She graduated from The Masters School in Dobbs Ferry, NY, and attended Sarah Lawrence College. After a courtship on Cape Cod, she married Benjamin Reeves Fisher in 1939. Pittsburgh, PA became her home for 60 years.
