



## Lloyd Joseph Hammond

January 27, 1929 - December 25, 2023

Lloyd J. Hammond of Naples, Florida died on December 25, 2023 in Naples, FL. He was born in Baltimore, Maryland on January 27, 1929, the son of Harry J. Hammond and Rosemary (Luperarelli) Hammond. He had been a resident of Naples since 2000, having moved from Reisterstown, Maryland.

Lloyd graduated from Calvert Hall College High School in 1950. He then served in the United States Army from 1951 to 1953. Lloyd attended the University of Baltimore and received his law degree in 1958. While attending law school, Lloyd met the love of his life JoAnn E Frazier on a blind date and they went on to marry on September 8 ,1956.

Lloyd enjoyed a long career as an attorney in Maryland. In addition to his private practice, Lloyd served as a trial magistrate, a Special Assistant Attorney General and the president of a real estate title company.

In addition to his professional career, Lloyd was dedicated to serving his community. He was a charter and life member of Council 5208 of the Knights of Columbus. Lloyd was president of the Sacred Heart Glyndon Parish Council, as well as chair of the horse show and incorporator for the Parish. Lloyd was instrumental in establishing a Senior Center at Sacred Heart Church, which was the impetus for the establishment of Senior Centers by Baltimore County, Maryland. He was a past president of the Reisterstown Lions Club and the 4th District Democratic Club. He was also a member of the Order Sons of Italy, Baltimore, Maryland.

Lloyd developed a passion for golf, which he thoroughly enjoyed while living in Southwest Florida. Lloyd loved the outdoors, spending time at the beach and playing the guitar. However, more than anything else, he enjoyed spending time with his wife, Joann E. Hammond. They were rarely apart, and they lived a long and happy life together.

Lloyd was predeceased in life by his parents and his brother, Robert E. Hammond. He is survived by his loving wife, JoAnn Hammond of Naples, FL; son, Larry Hammond of Baltimore, MD; daughter, Judy (Richard) Bosley of Reisterstown, MD; three grandchildren, Sara (Caleb) Fatzinger, Patrick Bosley and Claire Hammond; and 2 great grandchildren, Quinn and Maeve Fatzinger
