Lucy Caroline Urick, 83, of Bonita Springs, FL passed away Saturday, January 21, 2017 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice. Formerly of Wichita, KS and Shell Knob, MO, she had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 2012. Lucy was born September 18, 1933 in Central Falls, RI the daughter of the late Willis and Thetis (Livingston) Crocker.

She earned her Bachelor of Science Degree from Purdue University. While at Purdue, she held two freestyle swimming world records. Lucy married the love of her life, Gilbert H. Urick, Jr., on August 25, 1956. They enjoyed boating and raising their three children together.

A lifelong member of the Presbyterian Church, Lucy was an active participant in numerous women's ministries. She was a member of Phi Mu sorority (Purdue), the Women's Aeronautical Association (Wichita) and the Lions Club (Shell Knob), and served as a mentor to students in Shell Knob. Lucy was inducted into the Rhode Island Aquatic Hall of Fame in 1997.

Survivors include her loving children, Caren (Barey) Chambers of Olathe, KS, Linda Schmitt of Olathe, KS, and Gilbert (Donabeth) Urick of Bonita Springs; grandchildren, Cami Mariano, Kael Chambers, Drew Journey, Amanda Bonham, Cade Chambers, Landri Schmitt, Bayli Schmitt; and 10 great grandchildren. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her

husband of 55 years, Gilbert H. Urick in 2011.

A memorial service to celebrate her life will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, March 11, 2017 in the CenterPoint Room of the First Presbyterian Church of Bonita Springs. Following the service she will be inurned beside her husband in the Resurrection Garden.
