Lynn Hogan 74, of Bonita Springs, FL and a former resident of Teaneck, NJ died Thursday, March 15, 2018 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice. Lynn was born September 9, 1943 in White Plains, NY the only child of the late Matthew and Florence T. (Conro) Bruccoli. She had been a winter resident of Bonita Springs since 1995 before moving here permanently in 2009.

She grew up in Valhalla, NY and graduated from Briarcliff High School in 1961. After graduating high school she attended Penn Hall Women's College in Chambersburg, PA.

For 25 years she was employed as the Office Service Manager at Reichhold Chemical in White Plains, NY. She then became the office manager for The Presbyterian Church at Tenafly, in Tenafly, NJ. She held that position for 16 years before finally retiring in 2006.

Lynn was the consummate Beatles fan having seen them perform live 4 times during the 1960's and after their break up continued her love of the group by seeing Paul McCartney live on numerous occasions.

She is survived by her loving husband of 37 years, James E. Hogan of Bonita Springs, FL; two stepchildren, Lee J. Hogan and his wife, Lori of West Alexander, PA and Laure A. McCloskey and her husband, Ron of Bonita

Springs, FL; two grandchildren, Anna Ponce and Zachary Ponce and one great grandchild, Roman James Ponce. She is also survived by her cousin, Brooke Eaton-Skea of Brewster, MA and her three daughters, Anne Eaton, Taylor Eaton and Holly Pratt.

A memorial service to celebrate Lynn's life will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, May 19, 2018 at The Presbyterian Church at Tenafly 55 Magnolia, Tenafly, NJ 07670.

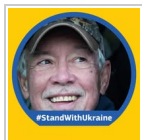

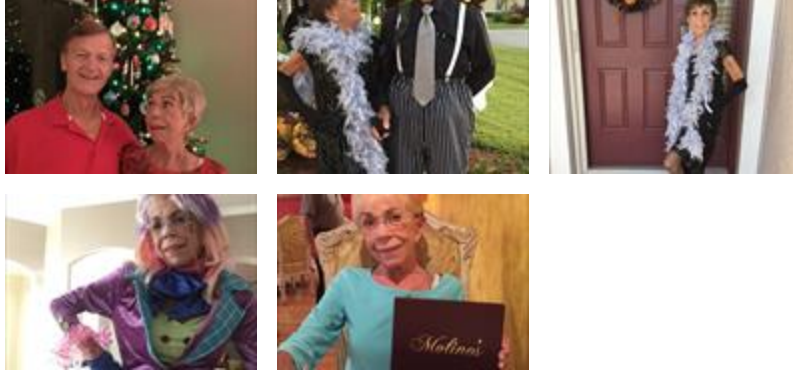
