



Lynwood F. Smith

April 16, 1930 - December 27, 2021

Lynwood F. Smith, 91, died Monday, December 27, 2021, at home in Bonita Springs, Florida. He was born on April 16, 1930, in Stafford Springs, Connecticut, the son of Lynwood L. and Elvira Smith. Mr. Smith was preceded in death by his wife of 64 years, Constance Herbig Smith, who died in 2017. He is survived by his daughters, Lynne Smith Juback (John), of Pittsburgh, and Penny Smith Light, of Greensburg, Pennsylvania. He is also survived by his beloved grandson, Jordan Smith Juback, of Pittsburgh, and a brother, Donald Smith (Marge) of Manchester, Connecticut.

Mr. Smith graduated from Stafford Springs High School in 1948 and earned a bachelor of arts degree in business administration from the University of Connecticut in 1953. During the Korean War, he served his country in the United States Army. Mr. Smith was employed by Elliott Company in Jeannette, Pennsylvania and Dresser Industries in Olean, New York, and retired to Florida in 1993.

To say that Mr. Smith was an avid golfer would be an understatement. He played at several of the world's premier courses, from Pebble Beach and Torrey Pines in California to St. Andrew's in Scotland. He shot 9 holes-in-one, one for each decade of his life. Even on his final day, he managed to play 18 holes at his home course, Worthington Country Club.

A lifelong, devout Episcopalian, Mr. Smith was a member of St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Bonita Springs, Florida. A memorial service will be held at a later date. The family requests that donations be made to: St. Mary's Episcopal Church, P.O. Box 1923, Bonita Springs, FL 34133.
