



## M. Louise Grantt

Margaret Louise Grantt, 80, of Bonita Springs, Florida, passed away peacefully on November 29, 2025, at her residence following a brief illness.

Louise was born on April 6, 1945, in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, a daughter of the late Joseph and Margaret (née Eaken) Hoffman. She was raised in Chambersburg, where in 1963 she graduated from Chambersburg High School.
