Manoug Anusbigian, 91 of Bonita Springs, FL passed away Thursday, February 22, 2024 surrounded by his loving family. Formerly of Northville, MI he began wintering in Naples and Bonita Springs in 1972 before making Bonita Springs his permanent home in 2010.
