Marc W. Turner, 63, and Kim M. Turner, 57, of Bonita Springs, FL both passed away Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at their residence of natural causes.

Formerly of Somonauk, IL they moved to Jupiter, FL in 2008 before relocating to Bonita Springs in 2011. Marc was born November 3, 1954 in Mt. Vernon, IL a son of the late Oscar and Joy (Whitesell) Turner and Kim was born April 17, 1960 in Joliet, IL a daughter of Alfred and Marlys (Sutton) Rucker.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Turner are veterans of the United States Army.

Marc's career in law enforcement started as a corrections officer in Sheridan, IL. He then was a LaSalle County Sheriff Deputy, Kane County Detective before serving as the Somonauk Police Chief. He retired as head of security at Illinois Youth Center in Joliet, IL. He was a member of the American Legion, Moose Lodge and was on the volunteer fire department. As a former scout leader he enjoyed backpacking, camping and fishing.

Kim's career began as a timekeeper for the Sheridan Prison and she retired as a business manager for the State of Illinois. After moving to Jupiter she held the position of comptroller at Trio Marine and Pirate's Cove Resort and Marina in Stuart, FL. She was currently working as comptroller a March Aviation in Naples, FL. Kim was a Past President of General Federation of Women's Club Illinois.

They are survived by their children, Marc (Leann) Turner II of Columbus, GA, Samantha (Brett) Killian of Crown Point, IN; and 7 grandchildren. Marc leaves behind brother, David; sisters, Diana and Julie. Kim's father, Alfred Rucker; and sisters, Kris (Brad) Eike and Karlyn (Jay) Hendricks also survive.

Funeral services for the Turner's will be private.
