Marianne K. Middlemiss 81, of Naples, FL died on Monday, May 17, 2021 at Physicians Regional Medical Center. She was born on February 23, 1940 in the Bronx, NY a daughter of the late Phillip and Frances (Kelly) O'Connor. A former resident of New York City, she moved to Naples in 2004.

After graduating from St. Pius High School, Marianne began her career with Chase Manhattan Bank. After leaving Chase, Marianne worked in the office of the National Football League as Commissioner Pete Rozelle's secretary.
