



## Martin Paul Bartholomew Schmeckpeper

December 5, 1970 - March 20, 2017

Martin Paul Bartholomew Schmeckpeper, 46, of Naples, FL sadly lost the battle against cancer Monday, March 20, 2017 at his residence and surrounded by his loving family. The youngest of five, he was born December 5, 1970 in Buffalo, NY to Robert Llewellyn and Jane (Conway) Schmeckpeper. After his mother and sister passed, his father remarried to Nancy Barry Stall Schmeckpeper and Martin was blessed to call her mom, as well as, gained 3 more siblings.

Martin was raised in Naples, earned his Eagle Scout rank with Troop 2 under Scoutmaster Charles Scholten and was a graduate of Naples High School, Class of 1989. He entered the United States Navy in 1990 and served six years as a Machinist Mate, Second Class, receiving four Bronze Stars. Upon his honorable discharge from the military, Martin stayed in Virginia and earned multiple certifications from Fuller School of Massage Therapy including his Instructor certification. In 2006, Martin moved back to Naples to be with his family and started working for Florida Cooling Supply, where he continued until shortly before his passing. He enjoyed playing poker while having a cigar and a Guinness, camping with his family, Dungeons and Dragons with his friends, and talking with his wife on the back deck. Martin's personality drew people to him and created a family wherever he went, he will be missed by so many.

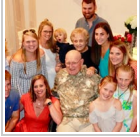
