Maureen Ann Robinson, 91, of Naples, Florida, passed away peacefully on November 15, 2025, at Naples Community Hospital after a brief illness.

Born on February 21, 1934, in Rockaway Beach, New York, Maureen was the daughter of the late Harvey and Mary (née McCarthy) Frem. She grew up surrounded by the ocean she loved and the warmth of a close-knit family. A graduate of Marymount College, Maureen earned her bachelor's degree before embarking on the journey that would become the heart of her life—her family.

Above all else, Maureen loved her family and her faith. She was a devoted parishioner of St. Ann Catholic Church, where her Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Saturday, November 22, 2025, at 11:00 AM. Burial will take place at St. John's Cemetery in Queens, New York.

Robinson of Naples, Florida; her brothers, Harvey Frem of Brandon, Florida, and Thomas Frem and his wife Laraine of Rockville Centre, New York; 9 grandchildren, 7 great-grandchildren, and 22 nieces and nephews.
