January 1, 1949 - May 16, 2023

Mireya M. Delgado 74, of Estero, FL died May 16, 2023, while undergoing treatment for leukemia in Miami, FL. Mireya was born on January 1, 1949, in Guantanamo, Cuba a daughter of the late Guillermo and Blanca (Fernandez) Alvarez. She had been a resident of Estero since 2007 coming from Miami, FL.

She attended St. Theresa Grammar School in Guantanamo and el Instituto de Guantanamo. In 1968, she fled Cuba to Spain and then to New Jersey where she reunited with her future husband, Orlando Delgado who also had fled Cuba earlier by swimming to the Guantanamo Bay Naval base and climbing the fence into American territory.

They were married in 1969 and in 1974 moved to Miami with their two children, Claudie and Orlando, Jr. In 1978, they welcomed their third child, Guillermo.

Mireya worked as a bank teller in both New Jersey and Miami. In 1992, she joined United Parcel Service International working mainly on international orders and shipments from Miami.

She is survived by her loving husband of 53 years, Orlando Delgado of Estero, FL; her two beloved children, Claudie Delgado-Feeney of Estero, FL,

and Orlando Delgado, Jr. of Miami, FL; and 6 grandchildren, Justin Feeney, Sofia Feeney, Aiden Feeney, Dylan Feeney, Lucas Delgado, and Olivia Delgado.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one son, Guillermo "Guille" Delgado who passed away on July 30, 2015.
