



## Nancy J. Krchniak

January 11, 1934 - February 12, 2015

Nancy J. Krchniak of Bonita Springs died on February 12, 2015. She was born in Waterville, Maine in 1934, the daughter of Blanche and George Spicer. She grew up in White Plains, New York and graduated from White Plains High School. Her formal education included a Bachelor of Arts degree from the State University of New York at New Paltz, a Master of Arts degree from Columbia University in New York, and a Specialist's Degree in Educational Administration from Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville.

Her career as an educator took her to public school districts in upstate New York, as well as Long Island, where she taught in the Plainview Public Schools. She married Stefan Paul Krchniak in 1961. In 1968, she and her husband relocated to Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville, Illinois where they lived and worked for 28 years. While there she taught undergraduate students at the University, and for fifteen years served as Administrative Assistant and then Assistant Regional Superintendent of Schools in Madison County. In 1996, she and her husband moved to Bonita Springs, Florida where Mrs. Krchniak became active in the Highland Woods Women's Golf Association, serving as President and later, Chairman of their Ways and Means Committee. For the last several years, she was active as a local artist under the name "Nanart".

Mrs. Krchniak is survived by her husband of 53 years, Dr. Stefan P. Krchniak;

one sister, Susan Spicer-Lee of North Carolina; a son, Steven Krchniak of Cypress, California; a daughter and son-in-law, Catherine and Daniel Katzenberger of Woodside, California; grandchildren, Kurt and Claire Katzenberger, also of Woodside; a brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Milan and Joanne Krchniak; and nieces, Susan Fordley and Heidi Flynn, all of New York.
