Nancy Bates Watson 77, went home to be with the Lord on December 21st, 2019. She died peacefully in her sleep in Bonita Springs, FL after a long struggle with Normal Pressure Hydrocephalus.

Nancy was born to Marion (Yates) and Richard Kenneth Bates on November 17th, 1942 in East Chicago, Indiana.

She married her one and only true love, Richard Glen Watson, on October 29th, 1960 in Knoxville, Tennessee. They were married for 59 years.

Nancy worked for South Central Bell Telephone Company as a supervisor for nine years and then worked as a housewife and mother, serving her family.

She was also a Co-founder of Watson Family Foundation, which primarily serves the indigent in third world countries, as well as other Christian ministries and charities. She was especially passionate about helping women in India escape lives of prostitution and enabling them to develop technical skill sets to help them make a living for their families.

She volunteered for both Hospice and Dare to Care and cared deeply for those she served. She will forever be remembered for her deep faith and love for Christ.

Nancy is survived by her husband, Richard, and her two daughters, Julia Marie Boles and Pamela Lynn Wolfe. She is also survived by her six grandchildren, Ashleigh Elizabeth Morris, Richard Alexander Boles, Abigail Leigh Boles, Taylor Crosse Wolfe, Trenton Claye Wolfe, and Tabitha Chloe Wolfe and her four great-grandchildren, Jeremiah Matthew Morris, Jackson Alexander Morris, Joseph Eli Morris, and Richard Brooks Boles.
