October 14, 1937 - January 27, 2016

Nelson W. "Pete" Quinby III , 78, of Bonita Springs, FL, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, January 27, 2016. Formerly of Easton, CT, he had been a Bonita Springs resident since 2001. He was born October 14, 1937 in Hartford, CT, the son of Sarah Isabel (née Aitken) and Nelson W. Quinby Jr.

Mr. Quinby is survived by his loving daughter, Alicia Quinby Mooradian and her husband Milton Calder of Falmouth, ME; his brother, Richard (Barbara) Quinby of Polk City, FL; and two cherished granddaughters, Emma and Grace Mooradian.
