Patricia C. "Patsy" Bruno, 83, of Bonita Springs, FL died peacefully Saturday, July 9, 2016 at North Collier Hospital, Naples, FL. Formerly of Trumbull, CT she moved to Summerfield, FL in 2005 before relocating to Bonita Springs, FL in 2010.
