Patrick D. Quinn 77, of Bonita Springs died October 15, 2023, in Naples, FL. He was born July 2, 1946, in Davenport, Iowa a son of the late Raymond G. and Hazel B. (Doellinger) Quinn. He had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 2004 moving from Bettendorf, IA.
