Pauline K. Bollinger 93, of Naples died Friday, April 18, 2014 at the Frances Georgeson Hospice House. She was born October 29, 1920 in Cambridge, MA a daughter of the late John F. and Mary F. Keating. Pauline had been a resident of Naples for the past 23 years coming from Westford, MA.

Pauline was a veteran of WWII having served in the U.S. Navy and was one of the first WAVES.
