Peter Nicholas Bergin passed away Thursday, February 26, 2026 at Vitas Hospice in Naples, FL after a brave and long struggle with Multiple Sclerosis.

Peter was born on January 30, 1952, in Boston, Massachusetts, to the late Nicholas G. Bergin and Mary Harrington Bergin. He grew up in Milton, MA, where he graduated from Milton High School, Class of 1969. Peter grew up playing sports. He was on the high school tennis team and was very active in town sports, playing fast and slow pitch softball, street hockey and ice hockey.

Peter graduated from Boston University in 1973 with a BS degree. He later received an MBA from Lesley University. With a mind for numbers, Peter found himself excelling in finance and worked in the burgeoning computing industry, earning several awards of excellence.
