Peter T. Quinn, 67, of Bonita Springs died Wednesday, August 9, 2017 after a valiant battle with cancer. He was born January 6, 1950 in Boston, Massachusetts, a son of Frank R. Quinn, Jr. and Margaret P. (Thompson) Quinn. Peter has been a resident of Bonita Springs since 1955 coming from Marshfield, MA

He graduated from Naples High School in 1968 and received his BA from Logos College in Jacksonville, FL. He was the owner of Quinn Plumbing in Bonita Springs from 1972 to 1987.

In 1987 he became the president of Manna Christian Missions. His heart was to support Hispanics in their walk with the Lord. He supported churches both here, in Southwest Florida and abroad. He had a special compassion for his friends in Guatemala. He even became fluent in Spanish so he could fully communicate with his Hispanic brothers.
