



## Peter S. Rudd

March 1, 1939 - September 5, 2017

Peter S. Rudd 78, of Bonita Springs died suddenly Tuesday, September 5, 2017. He was born March 1, 1939 in Schenectady, NY a son of the late Peter S. and Clara (Dinkleman) Rudd, Sr. A former resident of Monroe, CT, he had resided in Bonita Springs since 1993.

Peter graduated from Mt. Pleasant High School in Schenectady, NY and went on to receive his BS in Business Administration from Bryant University in Smithfield, RI. He later studied management at RPI Hartford campus. He began his career with General Electric where he completed the BTC training program. After leaving General Electric, he became a District Manager for Shell Oil and finally he served from 1980 thru 1993 as Division President and Managing Partner at Quamco, Inc. Peter was fortunate to travel worldwide much of his career and his greatest pleasure was to travel with his wife. In retirement, he delighted in cruising and travelling with his family and grandchildren.

Peter and his wife were original owners in Worthington where he was not only loved by all, but an active golfer and very involved all those years in the beautification and improvements of the club. He served on the Master Board and was President of Single Family II for the last 10 years. Survivors include his loving wife, Diane L. Rudd of Bonita Springs, FL; daughter, Dana L. Ricard of Naples, FL; son, Peter Scott Rudd of Norwalk, CT; three granddaughters, Olivia Lauren Ricard, Alexis Lea Ricard and Elizabeth Anne Rudd. He is also survived by his sister, Shirley Delewski of Upstate, NY, and several nephews and nieces.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Robert, Jack and Daniel and one sister, Doris.

A celebration of life service followed by a reception will be held Saturday, December 9, 2017 from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM in the clubhouse at Worthington Country Club. Rev. Fr. Michael G. Rowe will officiate.
