Philip Settle Englehardt, 87, of Naples, FL, passed away on Tuesday, February 5, 2019. Formerly of Vero Beach, FL, he had been a Naples resident since 2015. He was born September 24, 1931 in Springfield, MA, the son of Arminius John and Marian Frida (née Settle) Englehardt.

Philip was an avid sportsman all his life, fishing, playing softball and bowling. He joined the US Navy when he was eighteen and served on the USS Pawcatuck AO-108 during the Korean War.
