Raymond Alan Spinelli, 74, of Bonita Springs, FL passed away Friday, May 31, 2019 at his residence. Formerly of Valparaiso, IN he had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 2007. Ray was born November 17, 1944 in Weehawken, NJ the son of the late Silvio and Emily (Lacher) Spinelli.

He earned his Bachelor's Degree in Engineering at the Newark College of Engineering.
