Richard A. Baranski, 87, of Naples, FL, died Wednesday, May 13, 2015. Formerly of Cleveland, OH he had been a resident of Naples since 1992. He was born May 25, 1927 in Cleveland, the son of Adam Julius and Mary (née Sinarski) Baranski.

Mr. Baranski was a World War II veteran of the U.S. Navy. In 1980, he retired as a Detective and a 30 year veteran of the Cleveland Police Department.

Survivors include his loving wife of 65 years, June A. (née Novak) Baranski; his devoted son, Richard J. (Kathryn) Baranski of Naples, FL; and cherished granddaughter, Jillian Baranski of Naples. He was uncle to several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his brothers, Jerome and Erwin Baranski and by his sister, Alice Mazzi.
