Robert H. "Bob" Auman, 87, of Bonita Springs, FL died Sunday, September 06, 2015 at the Renaissance at The Terraces. Formerly of Salisbury, MD, he had been a resident of Naples since 1990 before relocating to Bonita Springs in 2013. Bob was born April 6, 1928 in East Orange, NJ the son of the late William and Edith Nichols Fairfield Auman.

Robert graduated from Penn State University in 1949, earning his Bachelor's Degree in Metallurgical Engineering. While attending PSU, Bob played the saxophone in the Penn State Blue Band, he was on the cross country team and the National Championship track team. Mr. Auman served in the United States Army and was a member of the United States Army Band during the Korean War. Bob had a 29 year career working for Bethlehem Steel Corporation as an Engineer, retiring at the age of 45.

After retiring, Bob purchased a McDonald's franchise and would eventually grow his business to 4 restaurant locations. As an avid golfer, Mr. Auman belonged to the Naperville Country Club, Green Hill Country Club, Vineyards Country Club and Collier's Reserve Country Club. Bob also enjoyed playing tennis and was a lifelong skier. He was a member of Music Makers Big Show Band and the Naples Concert Band.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 63 years, Phyllis (Trail) Auman; loving

children, Nancy Heyerman of Medford, OR, Richard Auman of Palm Springs, CA and Matthew (Amy) Auman of Catonsville, MD; grandchildren, David, Tess, Ryan and Allyson; and sister, Anne Sergeant of Groton, CT. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Katherine Callahan.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 17, 2015 at 11:00 A.M. at Vanderbilt Presbyterian Church, 1225 Piper Blvd., Naples, FL 34110.
