Robert Michael Ceasar, 91, of Bonita Springs, FL, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 21, 2018. Formerly of Marshfield, MA, he was a seasonal resident of Bonita Springs for many years until retiring and making it his home in 1992. He was born in 1927 in Cleveland, OH, the son of Dominic and Rose (née Dabbieri) Ceasar.

Mr. Ceasar was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving in Europe during the occupation following World War II. After attending Florida State University, he moved back to Cleveland where he met his wife, Nora, together for 60 years. They started a family and eventually moved to New York where he was discovered and hired by the prestigious Madison Avenue advertising agency Doyle Dane Bernbach. As an account executive he was entrusted with the Volkswagen of America account and was transferred in 1973 to head the office in Boston MA.. He oversaw this account until his retirement in 1992.

His interests included playing golf, cruise ship travel, listening to big band jazz music and drinking good wine and eating oysters. He held the distinction of being the oldest active member of Marshfield Country Club where he spent the summer months. He was an avid sports fan who loved the Boston Red Sox, the New England Patriots and the Boston Celtics, but also had a soft spot in his heart for the Cleveland teams.

He is survived by his loving children, Michael Robert Ceasar of Oberharmersbach, Germany and Victoria Ann (John) Ceasar Rule of Marlborough, MA; and two cherished granddaughters, Ava Francesca Rule and Lila Sophia Rule.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Nora Theresa (née Mazzolini) Ceasar in 2016.
