Robert A. "Bob" Clark 81, of Estero, FL died Saturday, April 13, 2019 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice. He was born September 30, 1937 in Cleveland, OH a son of the late Andy and Stella (Brokos) Clark. Formerly of Aurora, OH he had been a resident of Estero since 2002 and a winter resident since 1989.
