Robert M. Doody, formerly of St. Paul, MN, passed away peacefully on January 13. Bob was born on April 6, 1926.

He was preceded in death by John Leo and Elsie Doody, brothers John, Cyril, and Richard, and sister Lois.

A veteran of WWII, Bob became a resident of Naples after his retirement in 1993 from Doody, Mechanical, the company he founded in 1959. He served as president and board member of the Minnesota Mechanical Contractors, St. Paul Builder's Exchange and St. Paul Plumber's Apprenticeship Committee. Bob led an exemplary life of faith and commitment to family. He was a founding member of St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Vanderbilt Beach where he helped build the parish through his generosity and fund raising efforts. Respected as a mentor and champion of the less fortunate, Bob was an inspiration to everyone who he came into contact with.
