Robert Charles Kroupa, 86, of Bonita Springs, died Tuesday, February 4, 2014. Formerly of Baltimore, Maryland, he had been a Bonita Springs resident since retiring from the Federal Government in 1988. He was born November 23, 1927 in Baltimore, MD, the son of Edward and Ruth (née Coyne) Kroupa. He was a World War II veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps.
