May 10, 1928 - January 3, 2015

Robert Charles Voss, 86 of Bonita Springs, FL and Coon Rapids, MN died on Jan. 3, 2015 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice after enduring many illnesses over the last two years.

Bob was born in La Grange, IL to Arley and Mildred Voss on May 10, 1928. He graduated from LTHS in 1946. In 1950, he graduated from IU with a BA in Geology and was a member of Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity. In 1960, he graduated from IU with his Doctorate of Jurisprudence degree and was admitted to the Indiana Bar in 1960 and to the Minnesota Bar in 1964. Bob was an Air Force fighter pilot in the Korean War from 1950 to 1955. He received the Distinguished Flying Cross and he flew 53 combat missions.

Bob married Carolyn Coen in 1954 and they had 4 sons, Robert C. Voss, Jr., Frederick, William and David. He and his family moved to Minneapolis in 1963 and bought a home in Coon Rapids on the Mississippi River. He was an attorney in the office of General Counsel at Honeywell specializing in Government Contracts.

Carolyn died in March of 1996 and Bob met and married Katherine Newman in August of 1997. Bob and Kay spent winters in Tarpon Cove in Naples, FL until they bought their home in Spanish Wells in Bonita Springs, FL. Their summers were divided between their lake home at Ottertail, MN and their

home in Coon Rapids. Kay has a son Michael and a grandson Matt and granddaughter Lauren and her husband Nick.

Bob is a former Mayor of Coon Rapids and belonged to many clubs including the American Legion, VFW, Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, National Contract Management Assoc. and active in the Republican Party all his life.
