Roger Kent Oviatt, 75 of Estero, FL passed away Sunday, January 29, 2023 at Gulf Coast Hospital in Fort Myers, FL. He vacationed in Sanibel for many years before moving seasonally to Estero in 2015, also calling Cleveland, OH home. Roger was born November 21, 1947 in Cleveland, OH a son of the late Douglas Gibbs Jr. and Marilyn (Spelman) Oviatt.

Mr. Oviatt served his country in the United States Army Reserves.

He was a graduate of Miami University of Ohio where he earned his bachelor's degree in Business Administration. Roger worked for over 20 years as a business manager for British Petroleum. He then pursued his true passion and dedicated himself to helping others through work with the American Red Cross, where he presented disaster recovery plans for government agencies.
