January 18, 1936 - July 29, 2018

Ronald C. Grethel, 82, of Bonita Springs, FL, passed away on Sunday, July 29, 2018. Formerly of Loveland, OH, he had been a Bonita Springs resident since 1994. He was born January 18, 1936 in Dayton, KY, the son of William Frederick and Madeline Ann (née Wenderoth) Grethel.

Mr. Grethel coached youth baseball & football for over 25 years in Loveland, coached several softball teams, and was the “Voice of the Loveland Tigers” for several years. He operated a successful insurance business since 1959 and helped to organize the Loveland Chamber of Commerce. He was also a former Kiwanis Club President. He volunteered for several years at the Florida Gulf Coast University broadcasting studio, where he read news excerpts for the areas visually impaired listeners.

Mr. Grethel is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Jane (née Weierman) Grethel; his beloved children, Ronald (Wendy) Grethel of Loveland, OH, Andrew (Jennifer) Grethel of Encinitas, CA, Mark Grethel of West Chester, OH, Lucy (Rick) Cox of Loveland, OH and James (Kimberly) Grethel of Loveland, OH; and eleven cherished grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, Jacob Andrew Grethel.
