Rudy Helmut Morawietz, 86, of Naples, FL, died Sunday, June 12, 2016. Formerly of Jeffersonville, VT, he had been a Naples resident since 1988. He was born March 20, 1930 in Gleiwitz, Germany, the son of Richard and Agnes Julie (née Pohl) Morawietz.
