Aaron was woven into our lives with Love, Laughter and Forever Memories. He will be greatly missed by all of the lives he touched.

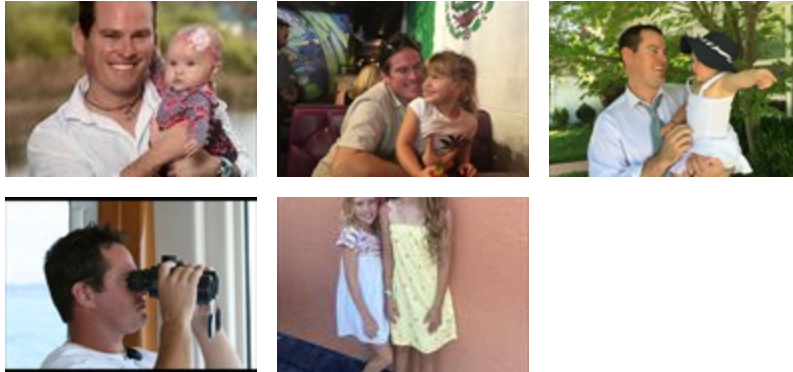
